2009 CKI Scholarship Information

Circle K International 2009 Scholarship Program

This booklet includes information about Circle K International (CKI) scholarships and the District Matching Scholarship Program. Students applying for CKI Scholarships must do so through the district scholarship application process or submit them directly as indicated. Qualifications for these scholarships are listed on page 3. If the district does not have its own application form, the enclosed two-page application form may be used. Districts will then send to CKI, one finalist for each CKI Scholarship offered. A CKI committee at the International Office will determine scholarship winners.

All scholarships are provided as cash awards in the form of a check issued to the college or university and the student. This check is sent directly to the college or university for deposit into the student's account and, most likely, will require the student to endorse the check. Checks are disbursed in August from the Kiwanis International Foundation. A copy of the letter and check is sent to the recipient's home address.

Recipients will be announced at the 2009 Circle K International Convention and posted on the CKI Web site. All questions regarding this program should be directed to the Circle K International youth funds and scholarship specialist, 800-549-2647, ext. 244.

2009 CKI Scholarships (amounts in US dollars)

- **Paul L. Frantz Circle K Past International Presidents' Scholarship**
One \$1,000 scholarship. This scholarship was started by past CKI leaders to show continued support for Circle K. These past presidents believed in continued emphasis on the strength of the club level. In 2005, the scholarship was named in memory of Paul L. Frantz, the 1978-79 CKI President who passed away in 2005 after fighting a courageous battle with multiple myeloma cancer. The scholarship assists and rewards club presidents who have demonstrated excellence and dedication to Circle K.
- **Himmel Scholarship**
One \$500 scholarship. Funded by family and friends of Harry S. Himmel, deceased President Emeritus of the Kiwanis International Foundation.
- **J. Walker Field Scholarship**
One \$1,000 scholarship. Presented since 1985, the scholarship is in memory of J. Walker Field, a past Kiwanis governor and avid Circle K supporter from the Florida District. Though wheelchair-bound, traveling around the divisions, district, and international organization was no obstacle for J. Walker to support his beloved Circle K'ers!
- **Cunat International Scholarship**
One \$2,500 scholarship provided by Kiwanis International Past President Brian Cunat and First Lady Miki. Based upon leadership in his or her line of study, regardless of grade point average or financial need. This application is included at the back of this packet and must be submitted separately to the address provided.

To apply for these scholarships, you must submit either your district scholarship application or the CKI scholarship application through your district by its deadline!

Kiwanis International Foundation-Circle K District Matching scholarships offered to participating districts

Application deadline determined by each district

The Kiwanis International Foundation and CKI have designed a scholarship program to recognize Circle K members who have excelled in leadership and have provided service to others. Financial need is not a factor in this award. Each winner will receive a one-time US\$1,000 award (unless a district changes the award amount). Districts are eligible to receive up to 10 matching scholarships based on the number of clubs participating in the Kiwanis International Foundation's Annual Club Gift Campaign.

Interested students need to contact their district administrator (or contact person listed below) to determine the district's participation in the 2009 program. **Applications for this scholarship are mailed directly to the district administrator, unless he or she instructs otherwise. Each district determines its own deadline.**

CKI board members and current Circle K district governors are not eligible for the District Matching Scholarship Program. Each district's CKI board determines the procedure to select the district scholarship winner(s). The district administrator must forward the winning recipient form and matching funds to the Kiwanis International Foundation by **May 22, 2009**.

The Kiwanis International Foundation-Circle K District Matching Scholarship recipients will be notified by the foundation, and announced at the 2009 Circle K International Convention and posted on the CKI Web site. All scholarships are provided as cash awards in the form of a check issued to the college or university and the student. This check is sent directly to the college or university for deposit into the student's account and most likely requires the student to endorse the check. Checks are disbursed in August.

You qualify for the Kiwanis International Foundation-District Matching Scholarship Program if you are a Circle K member who:

- Has been an active member in good standing with the club, district and international organization.
- Has paid dues and appears on the roster on file at Circle K International.
- Is at least a part-time college student at the time of application and after the 2008 Circle K International Convention.
- Has at least a B grade-point average, or the equivalent of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Has attached an official college transcript with an explanation of the grading system used.
- Submits the application to the Circle K district representative by the deadline established by the district. For further information, contact the administrator or representative.
