Dear Circle K International member,

There has been some confusion about what it states in the CKI policy code about one member holding two officer positions. The executive committee hopes that this educational piece will help clear up any confusion.

In order to keep the leadership opportunities open for as many CKI members, the number of elected positions is limited to one. This is also to ensure that the members in leadership positions are focused on doing one job great instead of juggling many positions. This “rule” serves to benefit the workload, responsibility and focus of a CKI member who chooses to serve in a leadership position.

The definition of an “elected” and “appointed” position is listed in the CKI Bylaws and your district’s bylaws. This information is usually listed under “Officers.” Please share this information with any member interested in holding two positions in CKI to ensure that all bylaws are being followed.

If you have any questions, comments or concerns about concurrent service, please do not hesitate to contact the CKI executive committee for further clarification.

ARTICLE 12 SECTION 5

Concurrent service.

No office shall be combined in one person and no officer shall serve concurrently in any other elected office within this organization.

TRANSLATION:

Concurrent service:

A member can only be elected to one position at one time. If the position is *normally* elected, the position is considered an “elected position.” If the position is *normally* appointed, the position is considered an “appointed position.”

An extreme example:

A member can be an appointed club chair, appointed district chair and International representative.
