

What is a Sub-region?

Greetings, CKI!

You may have come across the word “Sub-region” in various publications and scratched your head and said, “Hmm...what’s a Sub-region?” We hope this information piece helps you understand this important aspect of our structure as an international organization. A Sub-region is a grouping of districts that is represented on the CKI Board by the same elected international representative. Previously, districts were regrouped yearly and a “Trustee” was assigned to be the liaison to the International Board. One of the most significant differences with the new system (*implemented in 2007-2008*) is that now districts are permanently grouped together in areas geographically close to one another (See diagram of Sub-regions at right.)

Additionally, the change requires the CKI member representing the Sub-region to be from one of the districts in his or her respective Sub-region. This provides the opportunity for the representative to be fully informed on what it is like to be from that Sub-region. Previously, trustees were from different districts than the ones he/she worked with and he or she did not necessarily “represent” those districts. Rather, he or she was assigned by the president.

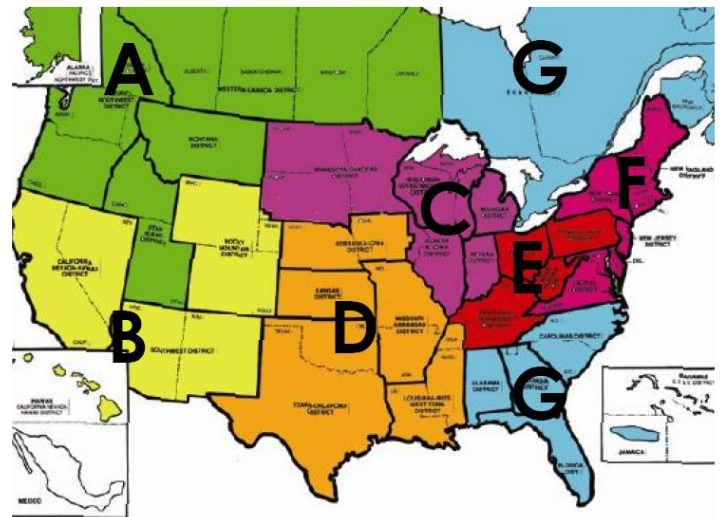
